Waterfront Access? is an experimental film that connects a group of people from the City to the Brooklyn shore. As the dance evolves through various landscapes, life and colors arise, unveiling a message at each location: *Just - One - Person - Can - Create - Peace - And - Change - The - World*. There are very few areas left in New York City where the general public has access to the waterfront; we would like this to change. This project is a collaboration between choreographer Floanne Ankah and set installation by Joe Zolkowski, with an original score by Russ Spiegel.

Floanne Ankah is a filmmaker, actor and choreographer. Born in France, Ankah has resided in New York City since 2000 where she works as an actor and voice artist on stage, film and television. She graduated from the Merce Cunningham Dance Studio in 2004 and has choreographed and/or collaborated for venues such as *Movement Research, Joyce SoHo, Dance New Amsterdam, Merce Cunningham Studio and the HERE Arts Center*. She began fusing the mediums of dance and film in "Brooklyn Bridge" (2006), "Imprints" (2007), followed by "ONE WAY" (2008, best experimental film, Big Apple Film Festival) and "Kirk Light" (2009).
